TECHNICAL AND SIZING DATA

When vertically stacking ladder trays always maintain adequate clearance above each tray run to allow for the installation of the cable and start with the narrowest (lightest) tray on top and work downwards

To Specify the Slope for Cable Tray

Slope is applied to cable tray in the Z direction of the current coordinate system in the drawing (typically the vertical direction for a building plan). In the Electrical workspace, click Manage tab Preferences

Cable Tray

All changes of direction must be supported in the immediate vicinity of the joints (distance ≤ 150 mm) by an appropriate supporting structure. Inclined cable trays
