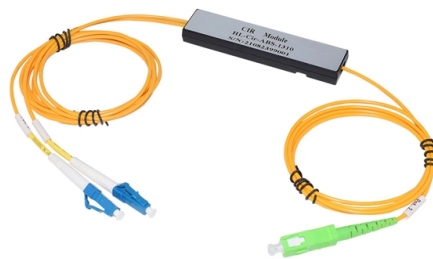


Distance between cable management rack patch panel and switch

Plan lengths around a consistent front-of-rack pattern—most commonly patch panel → cable manager → switch—and keep service loops small, intentional, and documented. If cords are long enough to droop into labels or force sharp turns, they're already too long for Day-2.
