

Fiber optic cable buried at a depth of 1 meter

Standard Installation: Fiber optic cables are generally buried at depths ranging from 3 to 4 feet (approximately 0.9 to 1.2 meters). This depth helps protect the cable from damage caused by digging, animals, and environmental conditions like freezing and flooding. Properly following these guidelines ensures reliable, safe, and durable network performance, minimizing the risk of outages and reducing long-term costs. Fiber optic cables transmit data as light pulses through a core, offering bandwidths up to 400 Gbps via wavelength-division multiplexing (WDM). Burying the cable too shallowly can expose it to damage from various threats, such as construction activities, agricultural equipment, and natural erosion. The short answer, based on general industry standards and the National Electrical Code (NEC), is that fiber optic cable is typically buried between 24 inches (60 cm) and 30 inches (76 cm) deep.
