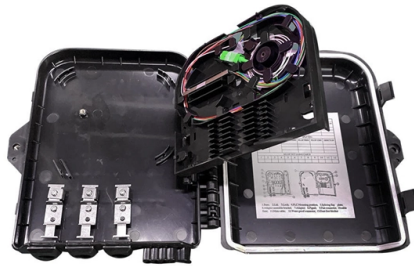

Approved Document M of the Building Regulations states that consumer units/fuseboxes should be mounted so that the switches are 1350-1450mm above floor level.
