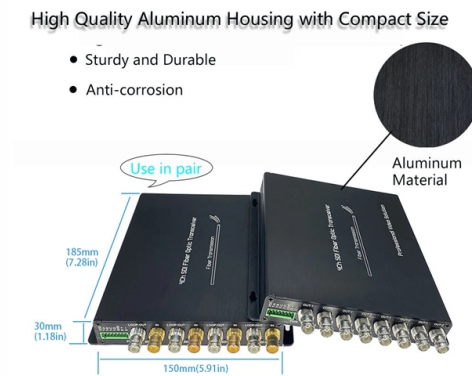


How much loss should be reserved in optical fiber cables

At TREND Networks, we are frequently asked how much loss is allowed when conducting testing on fibre optic cabling. Unfortunately, it is not a simple answer and depends on several factors. So how do you determine acceptable loss?

When testing fibre optic cabling, determining acceptable loss is. To be able to judge whether a fiber optic cable plant is good, one does a insertion loss test with a light source and power meter and compares that to an estimate of what is a reasonable loss for that cable plant. The estimate, called a "loss budget" is calculated using typical component losses for. This value should be determined by the system designer. 3 recommends a maximum value of 0. Fiber loss, or attenuation, refers to the reduction in optical power as light travels through a fiber optic cable.
