Remember, a box offset is small in up distance, about $\frac{3}{8}$ of an inch, so you need to barely get the conduit to bend. Once you have the first bend done, just roll the conduit over 180 degrees, scoot the bender shoe back a couple inches, and put the same type of bend.
