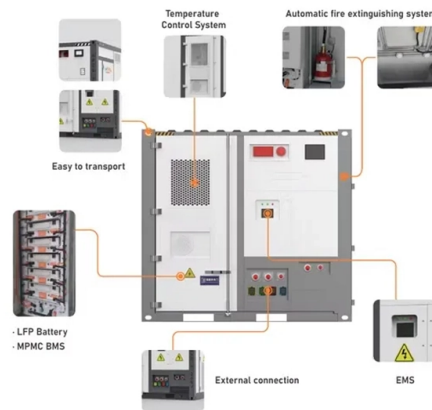


How to connect network cabinets end to end
