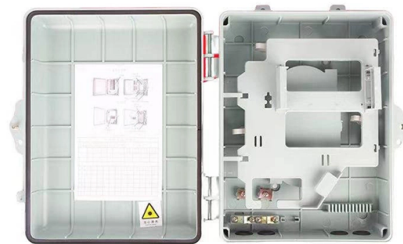


How to locate a large distribution box

Look for the distribution box near the septic tank, at the edge of the drain field, or along the outlet pipe from the tank. Check for access lids or covers in the ground, usually small, square or round, and buried 6 inches to 2 feet deep. The tank is almost always downstream from the main sewer line exiting the house, typically 10 to 25 feet away from the foundation. They're usually made of either plastic or concrete, and they have several openings on different sides where the drain field lines connect to the box.
