

How to perform broadband aggregation using a switch



Overview

This is often referred to as link aggregation, link bonding or EtherChannel. In order to configure 2 or more ports (up to 8) to be a port aggregate, simply navigate to Switching > Monitor > Switch ports and select the target ports, then choose "Aggregate". This arrangement increases throughput beyond what a single relationship could sustain, offers redundancy in case one of the links.
