

How to read the color of fiber optic patch cords



Overview

The standard multimode OM1/OM2 fiber patch cords are typically colored in beige or black, while OM3 and OM4 are aqua and magenta, respectively. Understanding fiber-optic color codes is essential for any technician tasked with installing, maintaining, or troubleshooting modern fiber networks.
