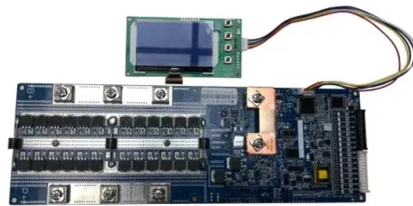


How to view the core switch topology diagram
