Wet-dry cleaning is most effective for removing most forms of contamination and eliminates electrostatic charge. Use Up/Down Arrow keys to increase or decrease volume. Even if the contact zone initially is clean, static can cause dust to move from the outer zone into the contact zone. Using isopropyl alcohol (IPA) is not a best practice, according to Sticklers®, because alcohol often leaves residues. A well-engineered cleaning stick makes incidental contact with the alignment-sleeve sidewalls, allowing fluid from.
