In 2023, the new 2Africa subsea cable (backed by Meta and partners) landed in Maputo (south) and Nacala (north), further boosting bandwidth and. In 2024, Mozambique exported \$558k of Optical fibres and cables, making it the 76th largest exporter of Optical fibres and cables (out of 167) in the world. During the same year, Optical fibres and cables were the 251st most exported product (out of 2,452) in Mozambique. In 2024, the main. Mozambique's internet infrastructure is heavily mobile-dominated, with three main operators—Vodacom Mozambique (about 50% market share), Movitel, and Tmcel—while fixed-line broadband remains minimal. Tmcel has accumulated over \$400 million in debt and is undergoing restructuring to avoid.
