Uneven flow is a direct cause of localized oversaturation in the drain field, which often manifests as unusually lush or marshy spots. A septic distribution box (D-box) is a concrete or plastic junction that evenly distributes wastewater from your septic tank to all drainfield lateral lines. When it fails, symptoms include uneven wet spots in the yard, slow indoor drains, and sewage odors.
