Double lugging at the service lugs occurs when multiple conductors are terminated under a single lug located ahead of (line side of) the main breaker. Service lugs are designed to accept only the incoming service conductors or feeder cables (Hot + Neutral for a 120V, or two hot conductors for a. "2S2" 2 AWG double wire lug, 2-14 AWG wire range, Multiple (dual) wire class B/C and FLEX, 4-12 AWG, 25mm²-4mm², wire class G-K including mm² class 5, double barrel, aluminum or copper wire, CU9AL, 90C temperature rating, single 5/16" (8mm) dia.
