

Usage per meter of cable tray support frame

Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: $\text{Support Quantity} = \text{Total Length} \div \text{Support Spacing} + 1$ $20 \div 2 + 1 = 11$ supports. In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports.
